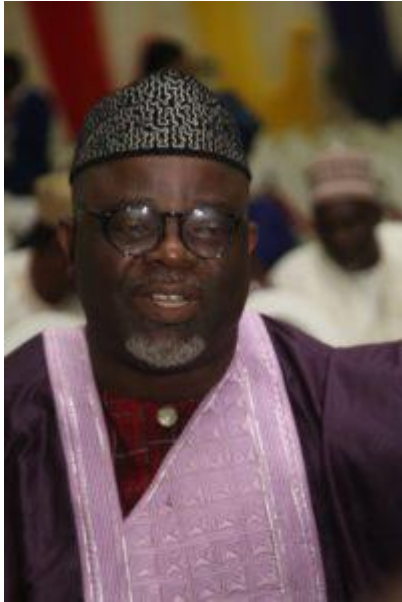


# The Roundtable Speakers' Profile
